- 1) The three-year full time degree programme, i.e. Bachelor of Arts(BA) is open to all the candidates who have passed the higher secondary exams or equivalent from a recognized board. This course is being conducted on an annual basis since 2017-2018 as per guidelines Department of Higher Education, Govt of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal. Also the admission to this programme is done through the online forum and is based on merit and statutory reservation.
- 2) The two-year full time Post Graduate programme, i.e.Master of Arts(MA) in Sociology is open to the graduate of Arts and allied streams. The course has four semesters, all of which are in institute's campus. During the fourth semester students have to undertake internship of sixty hours in different areas of service. The admission and eligibility criteria is as per the guidelines of Department of Higher Education, Govt of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal.

### 3. No. of Teaching Posts Sanctioned- Filled:

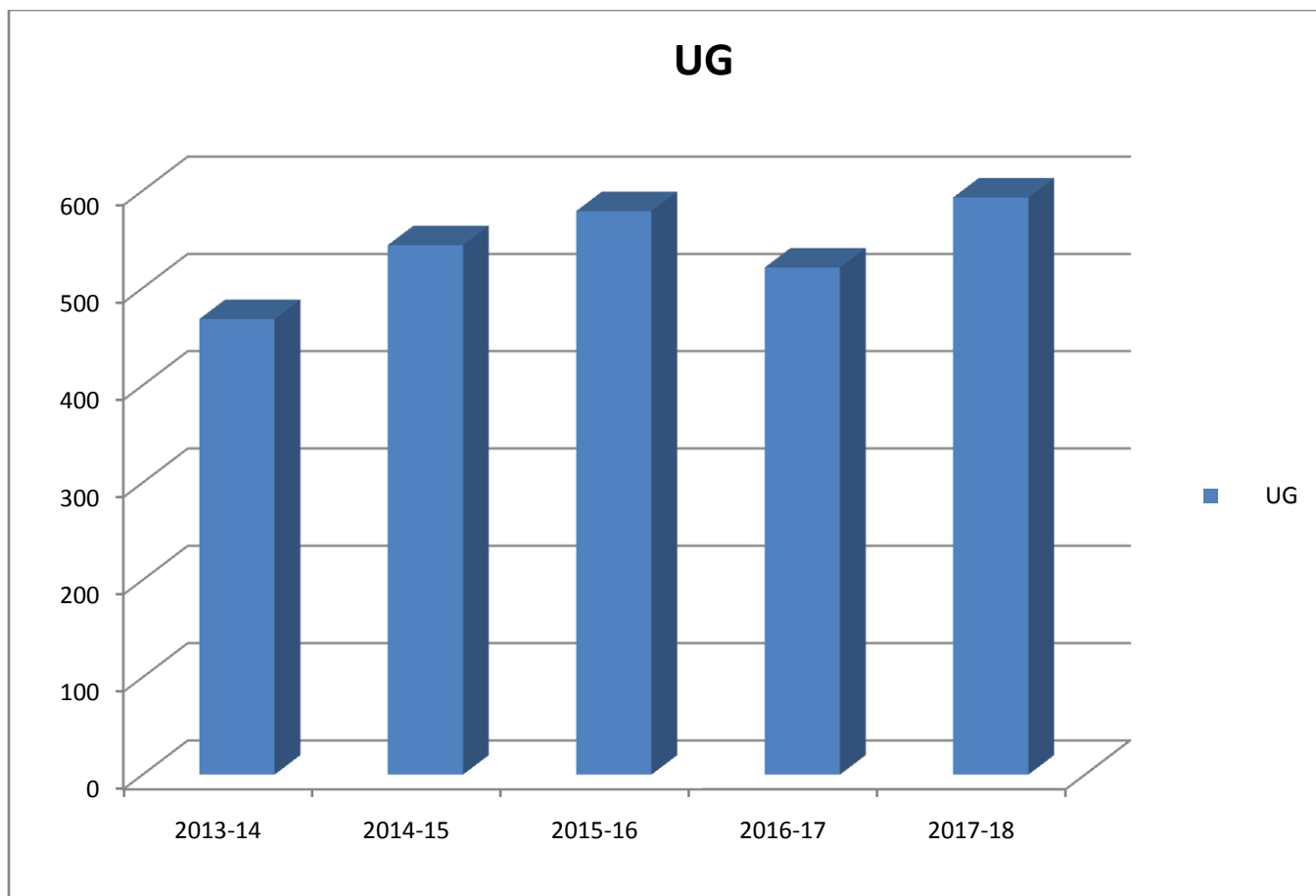

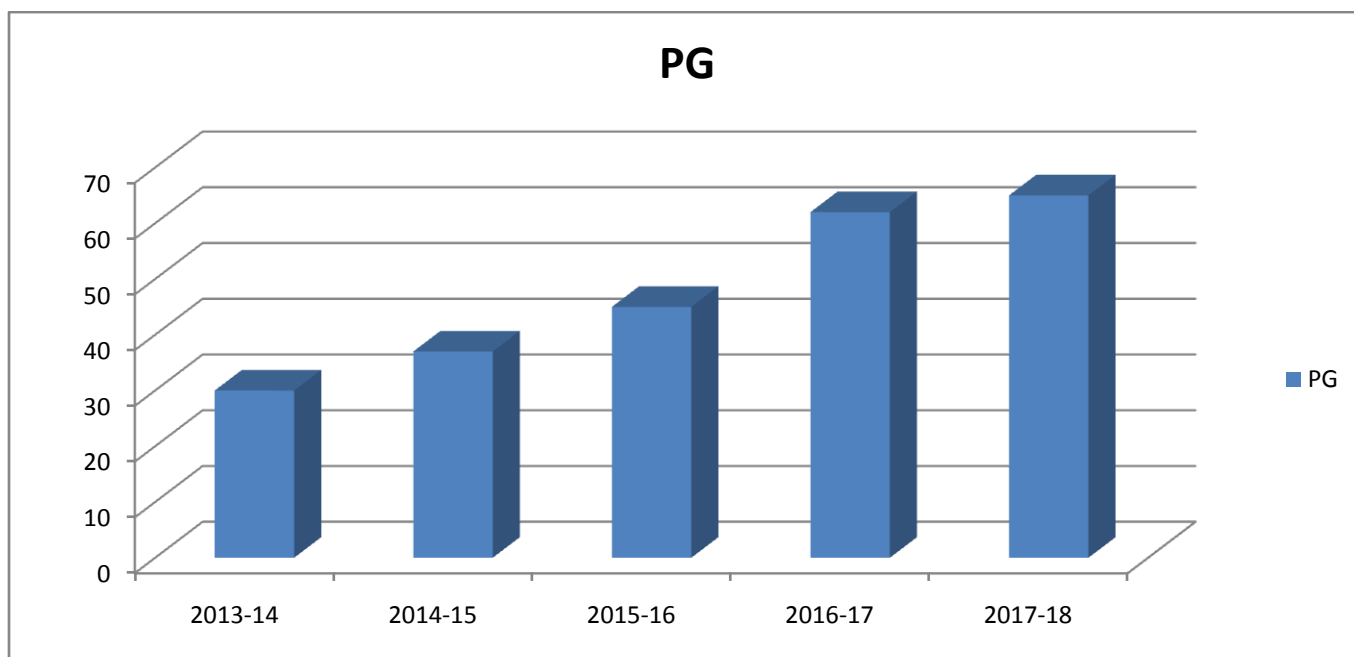

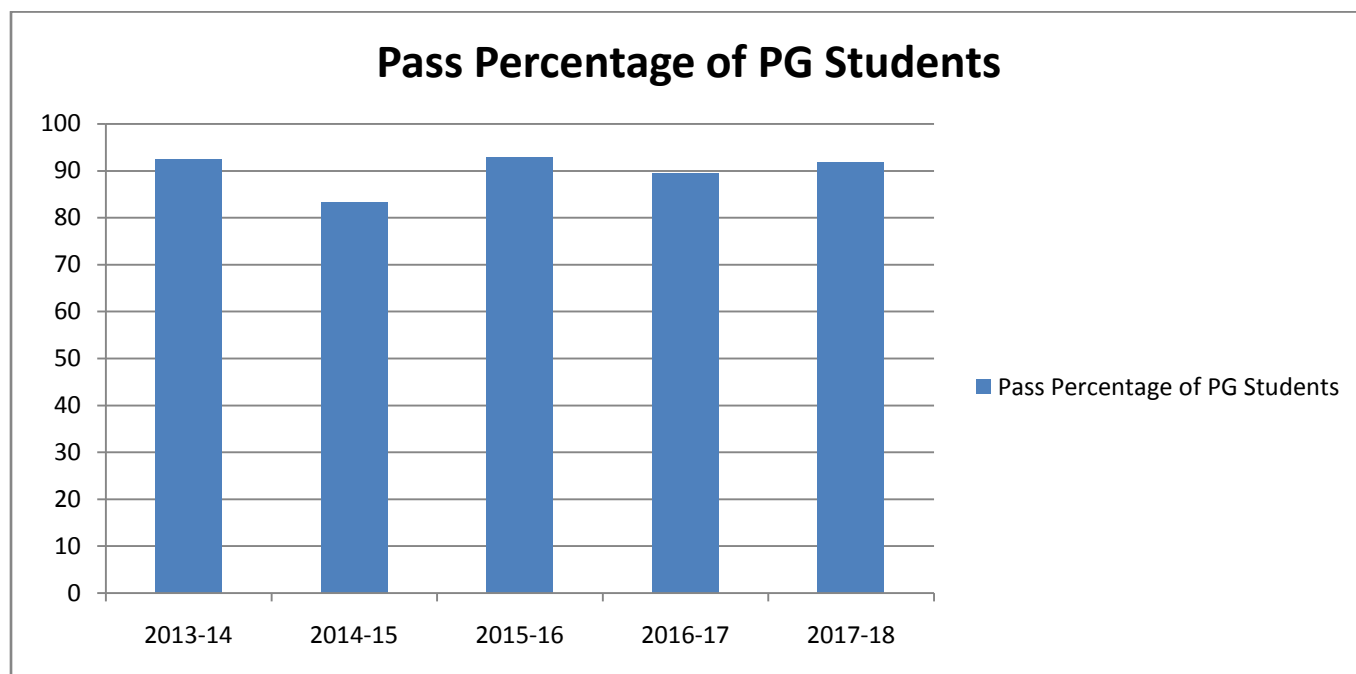
No. of UG Students Enrolled during last five Years (2013-2018)

## 5. Innovative Teaching and Evaluation Methods:

The department blends traditional methods such as class room teaching and the use of black board with chalk and duster. In addition to the conventional methods, following special innovative teaching methods are used to make learning more effective and efficient.

- Special interactive classes by applying group discussions, student participation, question answer session, all these help students to build confidence, stimulate response and improve their learning.
- Technology aided teaching encourages students to think critically hence interest is grown among the learners by virtual class webcasted by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal.
- To promote the sense of responsibility students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities for performing active learning from the department places emphasis on hands on learning through field trips.
- Hidden creativity of students is manifested through the publication of newsletters and board magazines.
- Teachers are available beyond class hours for academic interaction of students. They also resolve the issues related to social and Psychological aspect making them to learn real life adjustment.

Students performance evaluation is based on multiple criteria and guidelines laid by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal. In UG program semester system that has been adopted since 2008 has been replaced by annual mode of examination from 2017-18. Apart from this exam conducted as per academic calendar and the declared timetable internal assessment is done through quarterly and half yearly examination.

In PG program semester system still prevails. Impartial, transparent internal assessment in the form of continuous comprehensive evaluation includes attendance, discipline, behavior, presentation skills and participation in teaching exercise. Semester end examination are conducted as per academic calendar.

Few students of BA sixth semester sociology allotted by examination cell take up project work and all the students of MA fourth semester sociology join internship of 60 hours as a part of their curriculum. In both the cases students are asked the following:

- 1) To prepare a report
- 2) Deliver a presentation which is judged by External Examiner and Internal Guide
- 3) Marks are awarded after a viva voice examination.

## **23. Report of Other Activities- News Letter/ Birth/ Death Anniversary Celebration etc.:**

### **I. Community Outreach Program**

Contribution to society is not a charity but it's a social responsibility conceived from the notion that all of us need to express our gratitude. It is the responsibility of the individual and institute to give back to the society that nurtured them. Students are encouraged to participate at the institutional and individual level through following activities:

#### **a) Visit to nearby Government school**

Students of Sociology Department selected neighboring Government High School Pachpedi Jabalpur to teach the kids under child literacy programme. The team spent a little over a month with the school children and their main focus was on the education. Various curricular and extracurricular activities were undertaken by 15 student volunteers in October 2016.

#### **b) Interaction with Tiny Tots**

Learning and recreational activities were conducted for little kids at Angadwadi Centre No 24, Civil Lines, Jabalpur by the M.A(final) students of the department in the month of April 2017. The training of drawing, painting, art, music and hygiene was provided to the toddlers. It was indeed a very gratifying experience for the students as they could bring smiles on the faces of these kids, even for a brief period.

#### **c) Swachh Baharat Abhiyan**

Clean India mission, a nationwide campaign to clean up cities, towns and rural areas. Many wrong and unhealthy practices prevail in our society due to illiteracy and improper habitual activities. The need of the hour is to get rid of these malpractices by changing the mindset of the people. Son Singh Maravi of M.A third semester (Sociology) 2017-18 batch tried to achieve the goal in Gram Panchyat Tingan, District Jabalpur in Oct 2017 by educating rural people about throwing garbage into dustbin, hand hygiene and spread the message of cleanliness is next to Godliness.

#### **d) Elderly and Technology**

KIOSK banking is an important concept and developed for rural areas. To make elderly technology-oriented attempt was done by Son Singh Maravi of M.A third semester and Maya Ram Armo of BA 5th semester of 2017-18(Sociology) batch at Gram Panchyat Tingan, District Jabalpur. Pension matter of elderly about the biometric secured kiosk transaction was assisted by both the students as the branch of SBI is situated 15 km away from the village. It is widely accepted that the use of technology by the elderly population has benefited their quality of life.

#### **e) Rural development- Gramonnati**

Aarti Choubey of MA IV semester 2017-18 has undertaken her internships at Gramonnati trust which is not for profit social enterprise that aims to support rural transformation through technology entrepreneurship. Her knowledge and skill for digital literacy for Sanskrit and Hindi in rural area has improved the scenario a lot.

## **f) Paralegal Volunteering**

Madhya Pradesh State legal Authority proposed to start its unit in the colleges and selected paralegal volunteers among the students. Manish Dahiya, Bhanu Pratap, Rinki Varkade of M.A III semester (2016-17) and Arti Choubey of M.A I semester (2016-17) have given their services in Lok Adalat at Honourable HighCourt of Madhya Pradesh. They also participated in Legal Literacy Program at Panagar Tahsil of Jabalpur, M.P.

## **II) Gender Sensitization**

Gender discrimination is a part of gender sensitization. It is interlinked with gender empowerment raising awareness of gender equality concern was achieved by conducting various sensitization programmes within and beyond the class by different students, some of them are as following:

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### **a) Surakshit Kanya aur Surakshit Samaj**

Growing violence against women has been a matter of serious concern. Making society safer for girl child and to promote as well as nurture safe and secure environment especially for girls, awareness rally was organized by the students of sociology department on 17th September 2017. Our Honorable Principal, Professors and students participated in this.

### **b) Internship Assignment**

Eight student of M.A(final) Sociology completed their internship program at Vocational Rehabilitation Centre, Government of India, Ministry of Labour and employment (DGE and T) Napier Town Jabalpur between 1<sup>st</sup> Feb 2016 to 31 March 2016 successfully. They conducted meetings, discussions and personal interviews with differently abled person especially orthopedically challenged women. The internship enhanced their knowledge and academics and offered opportunity to acquire direct exposure to work on gender equality and women empowerment.

### **c) Training**

With the aim to promote gender equality, six students of M.A IV semester Sociology had undertaken workplace training from 28<sup>th</sup> Feb 2017 to 30<sup>th</sup> March 2017 at Department of Women and Child Development, District Headquarter Jabalpur. They acquired knowledge about administration rules and regulations, office management, discipline and implementation of schemes and facilities towards women and child which they may not learn about at home or in class.

### **d) Project Work**

The project work carried out by Shivani Shripal of B.A IV semester, 2015-2016 (Sociology) emphasized that education is one of the best tool to maintain gender equality. She managed to prepare a sample questionnaire on financial literacy of working women and got inputs from Chartered Accountant, store manager and banker amongst others. Her project work emphasized on the importance of financial literacy for women as a tool to manage their financial resources effectively, thus reaching financial security and freedom.



## **e) Electrical Winding- Career Option**

Huma Naz of M.A. IV semester 2017-18 batch has completed her internship at Electrical Winding training institute – Khan Enterprises, Raddi Chowki, Jabalpur from 15<sup>th</sup> January to 24<sup>th</sup> March 2018. Despite several challenges, she completed her internship successfully.

## **III) Govt. Directed Programs:**

Department also arranged some program as directed by the Government-

### **a) Dil se Baat-**

The Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Communicates with citizens across state through the popular radio chat show “Dil se Baat”. Aligning towards the Government motive, the department of Sociology collected suggestions related to the issues of women and girl students for this program to be broadcasted on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2017. The information was sent to the concerned authority by the letter no. 7159/अग्रणी/2017/Jabalpur dated 03.10.2017.

### **b) Posco Act Awareness**

In view of the Supreme Court direction towards the Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act-2012, the Department of Sociology with an objective to widely spread and propagate the provision of the act among the students, teaching and non-teaching staffs organized Poster Rally and Awareness Program from May, 2019 onwards.

## **IV) Newsletter**

The department always emphasized on providing students with important communications in writing to ensure they receive standardized, complete information that they can even save for future use. In regards to the same an annual newsletter is published/managed by post graduate students of the department in the supervision of the faculty member. Newsletter ‘Sarokar’ is designed and created entirely by the major batch of the department.
