Infrastructure and Learning Resources The huge campus of 61 acres accommodates Academic and Administration blocks situated in magnificent two storied building. A separate block of Hindi Department, HEPSN studio four store rooms, two seminar halls occupied by the legal cell of Additional Director's office. A post graduate block originally constructed as boy's hostel requires renovation. A lush green campus surrounds the college. The main block houses 50 rooms, which include two laboratories, two Computer Labs, Language Lab, library, exam cell departments, staff room and an auditorium of more than 1000 viewers capacity, spacious, well-lit classrooms, seven smart classes and one seminar room. Indoor sports complex has three badminton courts of international level and audience gallery with a capacity of 1000 viewers and a multifunction gymnasium. Basketball court and outdoor stadium has huge playgrounds, The Central Library has Wi-Fi facility with accessibility to INFLIBNET – an online library under N-list program. The catalogue is computerized and photocopy facility is available. There are also some rare books in the library. The post-graduate departments of the institute have their own Departmental library. A software named Read it Wand facilitates the requirement of differently abled users. Average number of login to eresources is 2500 per month. Further, reprographic services, current awareness services, book bank facility for the students of the weaker section of the society are additional services provided by the library. Fiber optic Connectivity for internet surfing is functional. The N-list program provides excess to more than 6000 e-journals and more than 97000 e-books. Parking slots for students and faculty have been extended to accommodate the growing demand. The infrastructure facilities of the institute have been further strengthened by the provision of ICT interventions such as dynamic website and portal, online admission fee collection, online generation of salary bills of the total teaching and non-teaching staff. With the assistance of UGC the institute has established a HEPSN studio. Innovation in the teaching practices is an ongoing process in the institute. The institute works as a laboratory where the ideas are developed and applied and tested for their feasibility and authenticity in the classrooms by the faculty.
